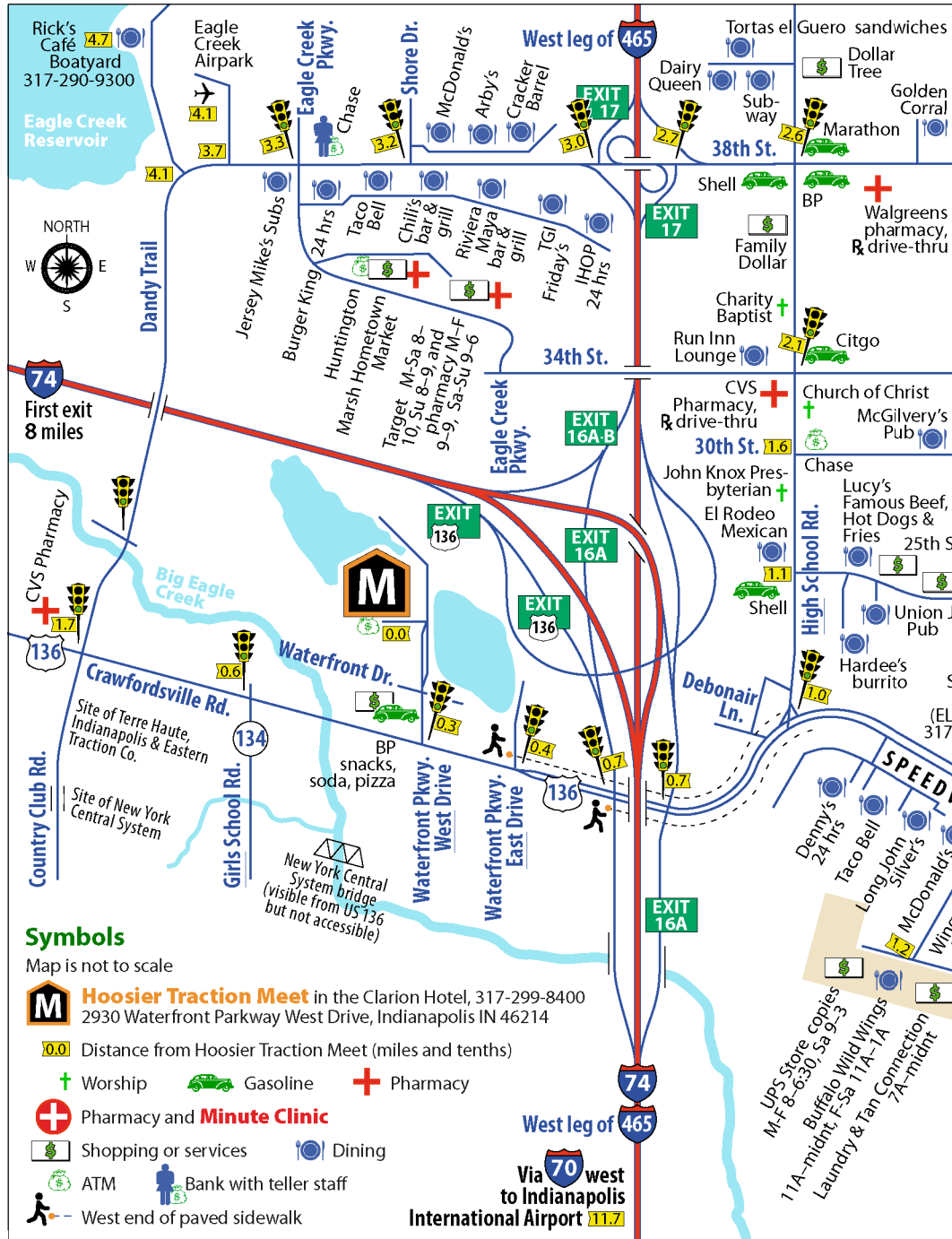


Near the Hoosier Traction Meet

Not so near the Meet

Downtown Indianapolis locations are described in relation to Monument Circle at Meridian & Market St.

- **Circle Centre:** Downtown shopping mall with dozens of stores, anchored by Carson Pirie Scott. Self-parking in connected garages. Washington & Illinois St., 1 block south and 1 block west of the Circle. 317-681-8000 simon.com
- **Indianapolis Motor Speedway:** Hall of Fame Museum 9-5; narrated track and grounds tours. East on Crawfordsville Rd. and merge into 16th St. near the speedway. 317-492-6784 indianapolismotorspeedway.com
- **Of transportation interest**
- **IndyGo:** The in-county bus system having 31 fixed routes, of which 27 operate along Ohio St., 1 block north of the Circle. Most intervals 30 or 60 minutes; half of the routes 7 days. Customer service M-F 8-6, Sa 9-noon, 34 N. Delaware St., 2 blocks east and 1/2 block south of the Circle. 317-635-3344 IndyGo.net
- **Transit center:** Being built south of Washington St. between Delaware and Alabama St., 1 block south and 3 blocks east of the Circle. Will have enclosed waiting room, 19 bus berths for specific routes.
- **People mover:** Automated rubber-tired trains on elevated guideway, linking two hospitals and a medical lab. Free, open to the public. East on Crawfordsville Rd. and 16th St., pass below I-65. Enter through Methodist Hospital.
- **Indiana Transportation Museum:** Steam, diesel and electric rail equipment; rides most weekends. Sa-Su 10-5. I-465 north and east to State Rd. 19, north to Forest Park in Noblesville, Ind. 317-773-6000 itm.org
- **Indiana Historical Society:** Home of Midwest Railroad Research Center. Tu-Sa 10-5, Th 10-8, Su (except library) 12-5. Ohio & West St., 1 block north and 4 blocks west of the Circle. 317-232-1882 indianahistory.org
- **Traction Terminal,** the hub of the Indiana interurban network of 12 radiating lines: Nothing remains at the northwest corner of Market & Illinois St., 1 block west of the Circle. The stone eagles from the trainshed adorn the steps of the Old City Hall building, west side of Alabama St. north of Ohio St., 3 blocks east and 1 block north of the Circle.
